First Covenant Church recognizes the wedding ceremony as an important part of a Christian marriage. With this understanding, the church will assist the bride and groom with arrangements to make the wedding a joyous, Christ-filled occasion.

<u>Pastoral Services</u>: A meeting should be scheduled with the Pastor at the time of application to discuss marriage requirements and schedule premarital counseling sessions. Michigan law requires a wedding license prior to the wedding service. This license must be given to the Pastor prior to or at the rehearsal.

<u>Ceremony</u>: All parts of the ceremony will follow in accordance with the beliefs of the First Covenant Church as described in the church constitution. Approval of this application is at the discretion of the Pastor and the Church Board. Inviting outside clergy to officiate is also subject to approval. A separate Use of Facilities form must be attached if a reception is to be held at the Church. Other than by special permission, no wedding ceremony will be held after 4:00pm on Saturday.

Throwing of rice, birdseed, or confetti is prohibited inside the church. Birdseed is allowed outdoors. Smoking and alcoholic beverages are not permitted inside the church or on church grounds at any time. Decor must not be attached in a way that compromises the integrity of the church and its furnishings. Dripless candles are allowed and should be used in moderation.

Other helpful information:

- The sanctuary's center aisle is 50 feet long
- The gym can accommodate 200 people
- There are 12 round tables that seat 8 each
- There are 20 rectangular tables that seat 8-10 each
